

New Orleans PACKING LIST

First Night at Camp Onomia:

Please bring a book that you have read, loved, and are ready to donate to a child/youth in need

Please bring your own pillow, bedding, etc... This can be in a separate bag, left in our vehicles when we head to New Orleans.

Luggage Rules:

We are planning to check our bags, but please limit yourself to a carry on size, as much as possible, plus a small personal bag (backpack or purse).

When we are in New Orleans, the stadium and convention center both have "Clear Bag" Policies. You will be given a clear, drawstring backpack when we are at Camp Onomia. There is also a clear or translucent water bottle policy.

You are responsible for carrying (and repacking) everything you bring and/or purchase while in New Orleans.

T-Shirt Schedule:

Sunday: wear to church what you'll feel comfortable in all day (church; car; camp)

Monday: wear what you will feel comfortable traveling in

Tuesday: wear your Synod Journey T-shirt (we will be given this on Sunday)

Wednesday: wear some Minnesota Pride (Vikings, Twins, School Spirit, MN Nice...)

Thursday: wear your Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd t-shirt

Friday: wear your orange Gathering t-shirt (we will be given this on Tuesday)

New Orleans Packing List

- 1-2 pairs of pants
 - one "work pair" for volunteering outside in buggy conditions
- 1-2 long sleeve shirts or sweatshirt/fleece layers
 - air conditioned buildings might feel really cold
- Closed-toed shoes (sneakers or tennis shoes) that you can walk for miles in - literally miles!
 - Once we arrive at the hotel, we will be walking everywhere
 - No flip flops or heels
- Rain Jacket or Poncho
- Pajamas
- Underwear and Socks for each day
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Cell phone and charger
- Translucent Water Bottle
- Sunscreen
- Lip Balm
- Toiletries
 - Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, tampons/pads, chafing relief/prevention; contacts/glasses (extra pair?)
- Medications (in original bottle/packaging)
- ID and insurance card
- Money
 - you'll need your own money for meals or snacks at the airport
 - money for offering at worship
 - tips for housekeeping
